If you are planning on joining us, please contact the hotel and make your reservations, fill out the registration form and send us the form and your check. The cutoff date is August 21, 2011. You must use the **Code: 261025 HMM-162 Reunion** in order to ensure you get the discount rates. The hotel allows 2 people per room for the discounted rate of \$85 per night. Additional guests per room are \$7 per night. If you need to have more than 2 additional guests per room you might want to look into the lodges which are also offered for a discounted rate. Please contact the hotel and they will get you the best rates for a lodge room that will fit your needs. You might also want to consider bringing the family including the grand kids and/or the great grand kids. It is a great place for young and old. You will not be disappointed.

In an effort to keep our costs in line with past years, we have decided to keep the registration fee at \$75 per person.
